## REGULATION 5<sup>th</sup> FISU AMERICA 3X3

Chihuahua, México 2023

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

*Article 1.-The events of the "5<sup>th</sup> FISU AMERICA 3X3 Chihuahua - México", will be organized according to with the most recent technical regulations of the International Basketball Federation (FIBA). In any controversy, the English text will be considered as valid.*

*Article 2.-The "5<sup>th</sup> FISU AMERICA 3X3 Chihuahua – Mexico" will take place from July 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023.*

*Article 3.- The "5th FISU AMERICA 3X3 Chihuahua – México", includes the following events:*

- One (1) tournament of the men's branch: a maximum of sixteen (16) teams and a minimum of six (6).
- One (1) women's tournament: a maximum of sixteen (16) teams and a minimum of six (6).

*Article 4.-Each team must be made up of four (4) student athletes belonging to the same institution of higher education.*

*Article 5.- For each tournament, each country can participate with two (2) teams, each of four players without substitutes. Countries can present a maximum of two teams per branch. In case of not complete the minimum quotas established in article 3, countries may participate with more teams, which will be communicated in a timely manner by the organizing committee.*

*Article 6.- Each country may enter a maximum of twenty (20) people, according to detail:*

- Eight (8) men (02 teams).
- Eight (8) women (02 teams).
- and a maximum of four (4) officials.

*However, this number of participants per country could vary only if the exception provided for in Article 5 of these regulations.*



**Article 7.-** At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of the Delegation or his representative duly accredited will confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the Committee Internal Control - CIC.

### COMPETITION FORMAT AND CLASSIFICATION

**Article 8.-** The tournaments will be held at the Rodrigo M. Quevedo gym in the city of Chihuahua.

**Article 9.-** The program and the duration of the competitions are set by the Executive Committee of FISU America in agreement with the Organizing Committee and the Internal Technical Committee - CTI:

**Article 10.-** It will be played in groups, each group will be made up of 4 teams and will play all against all (Round-robin), the first two places of each group will qualify for a second phase of 08 teams. The 2 (two) winners of each will be grouped into groups of four. Of the 08 they will go to the quarterfinals, this will be will play until sudden death, the winners will advance to the semifinal. The winners of the seminal they will play the final and the losers will meet for third place. The case for a minor stake to that established, adjustments to the competition system will be made in a timely manner.

**Article 11.-** The sowing of the teams will be based on the results obtained in the 4<sup>th</sup> edition of FISU AMERICA 3X3 – Lima, Perú 2022.



*Article 12.- The draw will be held at the Technical Meeting and will be managed with the Event Maker, the FIBA's free software.*

*Article 13.- To define the classification to the next phase in the event of a tie in the group phase, this will be decided by the official criteria of FIBA 3X3 (Event Maker Platform).*

*Article 14.- Each participating team must have their appropriate sports equipment for the competition. The light and dark background uniforms must be presented on the day of the Technical Congress and must meet the requirements established in the FIBA standard.*

*Article 15.- The ball for the competition will be of the Molten brand.*

#### **PARTICIPATION AND ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS:**

*Article 16.- Athletes must be at least 18 years old and not more than 25 years old (being born between January 1, 1998 and December 31, 2005).*

*Article 17.- Student athletes with academic status updated to the cycle may participate school that the event will take place, having to present the eligibility form of FISU América de digital form and integrate it into the accreditation computer system.*

*Article 18.- The following athletes may also participate:*

- Students graduated in the year 2022, who must present proof of graduate, with signature and seal of his authority or document that proves his condition.*
- Students who are studying postgraduate: Masters and Doctorates; minimum enrolled in 01 semester, they must present the file / proof of tuition.*

*Article 19.- For purposes of registration and participation of athletes and officials must Follow and comply with the registration procedure, presenting the following documents:*

*Step No. 1: Virtual registration*

- Enter the online system: CONDDE accreditation system through [www.condde.org.mx/fisuamerica\\_3x3\\_2023](http://www.condde.org.mx/fisuamerica_3x3_2023) with the username and password*

assigned to each, NUSF (National Federation of University Sports).

- Select the event, discipline and function to register the participant.
- Complete the registration forms: Intention to participate, quantitative, nominal and individual and travel form.
  - In the case of the photograph of the participant, it must be in color, up-to-date, in front and in the background white; the weight of the image must not exceed 500kb, in JPG or PNG format.
  - The passport or identity document of the participant must be current in color and legible (scanned both sides or color photo).
  - In the academic data you must attach the eligibility form or what is stipulated in art. 18th.
  - Illegible image or document will not be accepted in the accreditation system; the committee Organizer can deny the issuance of the credential, until the rectification of the documents uploaded in good quality and readable.

Step No. 2: registration validation:

- Submit payment receipt for registration fee (essential document).
- Athletes must belong to a single educational institution.

## ACCREDITATION

**Article 20.-** In order to participate in the competition, the presentation of the credential issued by the Organizing Committee. All participants are required to carry their credential as the only valid document to be able to COMPETE and carry out any activity in the sporting event.

- Athletes and officials will be required to keep their credential with them at all times moment and be prepared to present it for inspection by the members of the Committee Organizer.
- The Credential will allow access to the sports facilities, the premises of the Organizing Committee, transportation, lodging and other services.
- The duplicate of the credential will have a cost of \$15.00 US dollars and will be they



will deliver in a maximum of 2 hours, after having canceled for this right.

**Article 21.-** The registration of registrations will be according to the following schedule:

\*Closing of General Registration: Final Date of the NUSF (National Sports Federation University) to register your country as a participant in the event.

\* Quantitative Registration Closing: Final date of the NUSF (National Sports Federation University) to register their teams and the number of participants.

\* Nominal Registration Closing: Final date of the NUSF (National Sports Federation University) to carry out the detailed registration of their teams and the number of participants.

\* Closing of Individual Registration: Final date of the NUSF (National Sports Federation University) to carry out the individual registration of its participants in accordance with the requirements of the organization.

**Article 22.-** All Athletes must register on the website [www.3x3planet.com](http://www.3x3planet.com)

## PROTESTS

**Article 23.-** Any protest of a sports or disciplinary nature must reach the Commission Technique through the referee or the technical commissioner, no later than one (1) hour after the end of the game. The protest filing procedure established in the General Regulations of the FISU AMERICA GAMES.

**Article 24.-** The head of the delegation may protest against the decision of the Technical Commission this Protest must be submitted in writing in accordance with the General Regulations of FISU AMERICA GAMES and the FIBA Regulations as supplementary. This



*protest must be accompanied by the norm that is contested. A deposit of \$50.00 US dollars*

*must be made, which will be returned only if the protest is declared founded. The decision on the protest is final and unchallengeable.*

*Article 25.- The Organizing Committee will not accept claims for registrations, except for the presentation original supporting documents or certified by a notary.*

### **PARTICIPATION COSTS AND WARRANTY**

*Article 26.- The countries that participate in the 3x3 Basketball Championship must carry out a guarantee deposit of 25% of the total cost of your participation (\$500.00 US dollars) to more tan no later than June 3, 2023.*

*In case of not making the payment, the registration will not be taken into account. Likewise, the payment of the guarantee will not be returned for any reason, like the other payments established in the articles following.*

*Article 27.- 100% of the cost of participation must be paid by July 3rd. of 2023.*

*Article 29.- The fee per registered and accredited participant (athlete or official), within the considered in article 8, athletes and/or officials, will be sixty-five dollars (US \$65) daily including IGTV, considering the day of arrival at the hotel until departure from the hotel; and the FISU rate America are ten dollars (US \$10) per participant including VAT.*

*Article 30.- In case of additional registrations, the cost of participation will be assumed entirely by the delegation.*

*Article 31.- The Organizing Committee will coordinate and provide each participant with accommodation, food, internal transport and first aid. Air transport or land transport International will be assumed by each participating team.*

*Article 32.- Officiality. The referees will be appointed jointly by FIBA and the Delegate FISU America Technician.*

*Article 33.- In case of incurring additional expenses and costs during your stay, as well as in Damage to facilities will be assumed by each participating University.*

#### **HEAD OF DELEGATION**

*Article 34.- The Head of Delegation is the person who represents the institution in the meetings that he is summoned Likewise, he is responsible for processing the documentation of his delegation.*

*Article 35.- The Head of Delegation is obliged to ensure the good behavior of his players, within the sports venue and the accommodation, these and the player being jointly and severally financially responsible for the damages that the team could cause.*

#### **CEREMONIES AND AWARDS**

*Article 36.- As part of their participation, the NUSF must obligatorily attend the duly uniformed official ceremonies (opening ceremony, closing ceremony, welcome, and any other act that can be considered official). The Organizing Commission will inform the time, place and procedure.*



### **Article 37.- Opening and Closing Ceremony**

*The opening ceremony will have the following protocol:*

- *National anthem, the anthem of the host city and hoisting of flags.*
- *Parade of the participating teams; each delegation will be preceded by a banner and a banner displaying your name and emblem. The delegations will march in the order alphabetical culminating with the host university.*
- *The CONDDE Representative will give a welcome speech.*
- *The President of FISU America or the person from the designated Executive Committee will declare the event opened.*
- *Entry of the CONDDE and FISU America flags.*
- *FISU anthem (Gaudeamus Igitur) and hoisting of the CONDDE and FISU America flags.*
- *Oath of athletes, one (1) athlete chosen by the host university pronounces the following oath:*

*"On behalf of all student athletes, I promise that we will participate in the '5th FISU America 3x3 Chihuahua, México", respecting and complying with the rules that govern, committing ourselves to a sport without doping and without drugs, in the true spirit sports, fair-play, for the glory of our alma mater, for the honor of our teams and for the achievement of the university sports movement.*

- *Oath of judges and referees, one (1) judge or referee chosen by the Organizing Committee swears the following oath:*  
*"On behalf of all the judges and officials, I promise that we will officiate at "5th FISU America 3x3 Chihuahua, México" with all impartiality, respecting and complying with the rules that govern them, in the true sportsmanship."*
- *Participants will move to the reserved area to witness the rest of the ceremony.*
- *Cultural program.*

*The closing ceremony will have the following protocol:*

- *National anthem.*
- *Entry of the banners of the participating NUSFs.*
- *Parade of participants in mixed order.*
- *Closing speech by the Representatives of CONDDE and FISU America.*
- *FISU Anthem (Gaudeamus Igitur), lowering of the CONDDE and FISU America flag.*



- *The President of the CONDDE will deliver the flag to the Representative of FISU America.*
- *Cultural program.*

**Article 38.-** *The merit awards will be:*

- *Trophies: To the first three places.*
- *Medals: To the 03 first places.*
- *Certificates of Merit: virtual certificates will be delivered to the first three places.*
- *Certificates of Participation: virtual certificates will be delivered to all participants who have satisfactorily passed their registration process.*

#### **IMAGE RIGHT**

**Article 39°.-** *When registering for the event, all participants, whether they are professional players or not, automatically free of charge and with full rights, expressly and irrevocably and irreversible, authorize: The free use of any upload or charge of your name, your image and your voice in photos, files and / or digital media or not, as well as in posters, banners, films and / or spots, jingles and/or cartoons, in any type of media and/or promotional pieces, including television, radio, newspapers, posters, banners, direct mail, internet. In other words, tangible assets or intangibles, for the wide dissemination of the championship. The authorization described above does not does not imply or entail any obligation of disclosure or payment. Winners agree to authorize the use of their images, voice sounds and names, on TV, movies, videos, photos and posters, advertisements in newspapers and magazines, for an indefinite period, for the dissemination of awards or participation in future tournaments, as well as the use of the data contained in the record to communicate future actions promotional, without any charge for the organization of the competition.*
